1 WHEREUPON, the following proceedings were
2 had and testimony taken, to-wit:

3 * * * * *

4 PRESIDING OFFICER MOSER: This hearing
5 is called to order. Let the record show that it
6 is 10:31 a.m. on November 29th, 2023. This
7 hearing is taking place in person in Room 111 of
8 the Metcalf Building, 1520 East Sixth Avenue,
9 Helena, Montana and virtually via Zoom. The
10 meeting will be recorded.

11 This is the time and place set for the
12 public hearing in the matter of the amendment of
13 ARM 17.30.501, 17.30.502, 17.30.606, 17.30.617,
14 17.30.619, 17.30.630, 17.30.702, 17.30.706,
15 17.30.708, 17.30.1007, 17.30.1102, 17.30.1201,
16 17.30.1202, 17.30.1203, 17.30.1206, 17.30.1207,
17 17.30.1211, 17.30.1212, 17.30.1304, 17.30.1322,
18 17.30.1330, 17.30.1331, 17.30.1334, 17.30.1341,
19 17.30.1342, 17.30.1343, 17.30.1344, 17.30.1345,
20 17.30.1346, 17.30.1354, 17.30.1361, 17.30.1803,
21 and 17.30.1806 pertaining to the transfer of
22 rulemaking authority from the Board of
23 Environmental Review to the Department of
24 Environmental Quality.

25 This proposal was originally published

1 in the Montana Administrative Register in MAR
2 Notice No. 17-432C at Pages 1136 through 1148 on
3 October 6th, 2023. My name is Kurt Moser. I'm an
4 attorney with the Montana Department of
5 Environmental Quality. I will preside over the
6 hearing today.

7 Section 2-4-302 Sub(7) MCA and
8 Administrative Rule of Montana 1.3.311 require me
9 to read the Notice of Function of the
10 Administrative Rule Review Committee. It is as
11 follows.

12 Notice of Function of the Administrative
13 Rule Review Committees, Interim Committees, and
14 the Environmental Quality Council. Administrative
15 rule review is a function of the interim
16 committees and the Environmental Quality Council.
17 These interim committees and the EQC have
18 administrative rule review, program evaluation,
19 and monitoring functions for the following
20 executive branch agencies and the entities
21 attached to agencies for administrative purposes.

22 For the Economic Affairs Interim
23 Committee, the Department of Agriculture, the
24 Department of Commerce, the Department of Labor
25 and Industry, the Department of Livestock, the

1 Office of the State Auditor and Insurance
2 Commissioner, Office of Economic Development,
3 Division of Banking and Financial Institutions,
4 Alcoholic Beverages Control Commission, and the
5 Cannabis Control Division.

6 For the Education Interim Committee, the
7 State Board of Education, the Board of Public
8 Education, Board of Regents of Higher Education,
9 the Office of Public Instruction, Montana
10 Historical Society, and the Montana State Library.

11 For the Children, Families, Health and
12 Human Services Interim Committee, the Department
13 of Public Health and Human Services.

14 For the Law and Justice Interim
15 Committee, the Department of Corrections and the
16 Department of Justice.

17 For the Energy and Telecommunications
18 Interim Committee, the Department of Public
19 Service Regulation.

20 For the Revenue Interim Committee, the
21 Department of Revenue, and the Montana Tax Appeal
22 Board.

23 For the State Administration and
24 Veterans Affairs Interim Committee, the Department
25 of Administration, Montana Public Employee

1 Retirement Administration, Board of Investments,
2 the Department of Military Affairs, Office of the
3 Secretary of State, Office of the Commission of
4 Political Practices.

5 For the Environmental Quality Council,
6 the Department of Environment Quality, Department
7 of Fish, Wildlife and Parks, and the Department of
8 Natural Resources and Conservation.

9 For the Water Policy Interim Committee,
10 where the primary concern is the quality or
11 quantity of water, the Department of Environmental
12 Quality, Department of Fish, Wildlife and Parks,
13 and the Department of Natural Resources and
14 Conservation.

15 These interim committees and the EQC
16 have the authority to make recommendations to an
17 agency regarding the adoption, amendment, or
18 repeal of a rule, or to request that the agency
19 prepare a statement of the estimated economic
20 impact of a proposal.

21 They also may poll the members of the
22 Legislature to determine if a proposed rule is
23 consistent with the intent of the Legislature, or
24 during a legislative session introduce a bill
25 repealing a rule, or directing an agency to adopt

1 or amend a rule, or a joint resolution
2 recommending that any agency adopt, amend, or
3 repeal a rule.

4 The interim committees and the EQC
5 welcome comments, and invite members of the public
6 to appear before them, or to send written
7 statements in order to bring to their attention
8 any difficulties with the existing or proposed
9 rules. The mailing address is P.O. Box 201706,
10 Helena, Montana, 59620-1706.

11 That completes the reading of the Notice
12 of Function of Administrative Rule Review
13 Committees.

14 I'm also advising everyone present today
15 of the requirement in Montana law that agencies of
16 State government create and maintain a list of
17 persons who are interested in that agency's
18 rulemaking proceedings. An agency's interested
19 persons list must indicate the subject or subjects
20 in which each person on the list is interested.
21 Persons whose names are on the list will receive
22 notice by mail of all agency rulemaking notices in
23 the subjects indicated.

24 Anyone attending today who would like to
25 have his or her name placed on the Department of

1 Environmental Quality's interested person list may
2 do so by filling out one of the forms available by
3 the door today, and leaving them with me at the
4 close of the hearing, or by making a written
5 request to Loryn Johnson, paralegal, at the
6 Department of Environmental Quality, 1520 East
7 Sixth Avenue, P.O. Box 200901, Helena, Montana,
8 59620; fax a request to 406-444-4386; or email a
9 request to Loryn Johnson at lorynjohnson2@mt.gov.

10 Please indicate which area of rulemaking
11 interests you so that the Department can notify
12 you of a future rulemaking hearing in that area.

13 Notice of this hearing was published on
14 October 6th, 2023 in the 2023 Montana
15 Administrative Register at Pages 1036 through 1048
16 of Issue No. 19, and under Notice No. 17-432C.

17 As required by ARM 1.3.311 of the
18 Secretary of State's model rules, which have been
19 adopted by the Department, I'm required to
20 summarize the major provisions of the hearing
21 notice.

22 Paragraph 3 of the hearing notice sets
23 forth the general reason statement for the
24 amendments to the rules by reference today as
25 follows.

1 During the 2021 legislative session, the
2 Legislature passed Senate Bill 233. Senate Bill
3 233 reassigned and transferred the rulemaking
4 duties and powers of the Board of Environmental
5 Review to the Department.

6 In addition, Senate Bill 233 repealed
7 statutory code section 75-6-103, 75-10-106,
8 82-4-111, and 82-4-204. That's in the Montana
9 Code Annotated.

10 Through this rulemaking, the Department
11 will be implementing the 2021 changes to
12 rulemaking authority by striking "or" and changing
13 it to "Department." The Department will also
14 update the citations to the Montana Code Annotated
15 sections that have been repealed by Senate Bill
16 233.

17 The Department is making these changes
18 to implement the 2021 statute, and to clarify the
19 change of authority, to make it easier for the
20 general public and the regulated community to
21 determine the appropriate process and entity for
22 future rulemakings.

23 Paragraph 4 of the hearing notice sets
24 forth the text of the proposed amended rules I
25 referenced today, and the additional reason

1 statements for the amendments to ARM 17.30.1806,
2 and the legal authorities for all the amendments.

3 Because of the length, I will not read
4 the amended rules, the additional reasons
5 statement, or the legal authorities into the
6 record. A complete copy of the hearing notice
7 will be included in the official record of this
8 hearing and copies are available here today.

9 Paragraph 5 of the hearing notice
10 notifies the public that interested persons may
11 submit their data, views, or arguments either
12 orally or in writing at this hearing. The notice
13 also indicated that individuals may submit written
14 data, views, or arguments to the Department of
15 Environmental Quality no later than 11:59 p.m. on
16 December 1st, 2023. To be guaranteed
17 consideration, mailed comments must be postmarked
18 on or before that date.

19 Paragraph 8 gives notice that the
20 Department maintains rulemaking interested persons
21 lists, and indicates how persons may have their
22 names placed on a list to receive notifications
23 from the Department regarding rulemaking matters.

24 The Department is required by Montana
25 Code Annotated 2-4-302 Sub(7) Sub (b) to send a

1 copy of each proposed notice of rulemaking to
2 interested persons who have requested to be
3 informed of the Department's rulemaking
4 proceedings, or if a person has consented
5 electronic notification that the proposal notice
6 is available on the Department's website with a
7 link that contains the notice.

8 The order of presentation of testimony
9 today will be as follows: I will ask a
10 representative of the Department to provide an
11 introductory statement about this proposed
12 rulemaking. I will then ask to hear testimony of
13 proponents of the rule, first those appearing in
14 person, and then those online. We will then hear
15 testimony of opponents of the rule, the
16 amendments, in person, then online. Then we will
17 hear statements of anyone else wishing to be heard
18 in person and then online.

19 Finally, I'll ask for any written
20 comments of any person who does not submit oral
21 testimony today, if someone wishes to provide
22 them. If you wish to present data, views,
23 arguments, or other testimony, either orally or in
24 writing, please write your name, address, and
25 affiliation on the sign-ups sheets that are

1 available near the back of the room. Please also
2 indicate whether you support or oppose the
3 proposed rule amendment.

4 If you are appearing online via Zoom,
5 and wish to present data, views, arguments, or
6 other testimony, please write your name, address,
7 and affiliation in the chat feature of the Zoom
8 platform. Please also indicate whether you
9 support or oppose the proposed rule amendments or
10 no take no position in the chat feature.

11 If you are appearing online and wish to
12 present written testimony, please postmark mail no
13 later than Friday, December 1st, 2023, or fax or
14 email the Department as indicated in the notice.

15 This is an informational hearing, the
16 purpose of which is to hear any and all relevant
17 comments regarding the proposed amendments.

18 Formal Rules of Evidence will not be observed, but
19 testimony must be relevant to the matter at issue
20 in this hearing, that is, the proposed amendments
21 to the rules I referenced here today pertaining to
22 transfer of rulemaking authority from the Board of
23 Environmental Review to the Department of
24 Environmental Quality.

25 Copies of the proposed amendments are

1 available here today. As the Presiding Officer, I
2 may also examine any witnesses making a statement
3 here today. If you are appearing virtually on
4 Zoom, please use the raise hand feature in the
5 Zoom application to indicate you would like to
6 speak. When you are called upon to speak, DEQ
7 will unmute you. If you are joining by phone,
8 press star nine to raise your hand, and press star
9 six to mute or unmute yourself.

10 Prior to giving any testimony here
11 today, please identify yourself by name, address,
12 and affiliation, if any. I will now ask the
13 representative from the Department to present an
14 introductory statement. Lindsey.

15 MS. KRYWARUCHKA: Good morning. My name
16 is Lindsey Krywaruchka, that's
17 K-R-Y-W-A-R-U-C-H-K-A for the record, and I'm the
18 Division Administrator for the Water Quality
19 Division at the Department of Environmental
20 Quality. I'm here to provide an introductory
21 statement concerning the purpose of the rulemaking
22 that is the subject of this hearing today, MAR
23 Notice No. 17-432C.

24 During the 2021 legislative session, the
25 Legislature passed Senate Bill 233. Senate Bill

1 233 reassigned and transferred most rulemaking
2 duties from the Board of Environmental Review to
3 the Department of Environmental Quality.

4 Through this rulemaking and related
5 rulemaking, the Department will be implementing
6 the 2021 statutory changes to rulemaking authority
7 by removing references to the Board, and changing
8 it to Department.

9 The Department is making these changes
10 to clarify the change of authority, and to make it
11 easier for the public and the regulated community
12 to determine the appropriate process and entity
13 for future rulemaking. Keeping certain references
14 to the Board in the rules is also misleading, may
15 cause confusion, and is inconsistent with statute.

16 Due to the large number of ARMs that
17 were affected by Senate Bill 233, the Department
18 separate them into five parts: MAR Notice 17-432
19 "A," "B," "C," "D," and "E." This hearing
20 specifically concerns MAR Notice No. 17-432C, the
21 portion of the rulemaking that concerns water
22 quality rules.

23 Although this rulemaking is being
24 conducted for clarification purposes, and does not
25 concern substantive amendments, out of an

1 abundance of caution this hearing is being held to
2 ensure any applicable federal hearing requirements
3 are met.

4 I have several documents to submit for
5 the record, and a copy of the Department's
6 introductory statement which I have just read, an
7 analysis prepared by the Department that the
8 proposed rules will not significantly and directly
9 impact small businesses, and an analysis that
10 these rule changes are not more stringent than
11 federal regulations or guidelines, and do not have
12 takings implications.

13 This concludes the Department's
14 introductory statement. Thank you.

15 PRESIDING OFFICER MOSER: Thank you. I
16 am now accepting those documents into the record
17 of the hearing. Is there anyone online at all?

18 MS. JOHNSON: No.

19 PRESIDING OFFICER MOSER: And there is
20 no one in the room that wishes to present
21 testimony?

22 (No response)

23 PRESIDING OFFICER MOSER: I guess
24 there's no further information required then.
25 Thanks for your attendance and testimony. The

1 hearing is now adjourned.

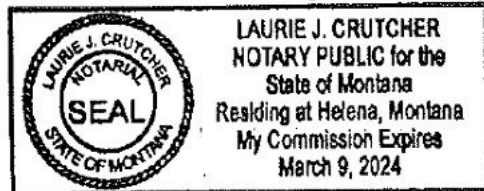
